With this beginner friendly crochet pattern for organic cotton face scrubbies, you can ditch the disposable wipes and cotton wool pads for a washable, reusable and eco-friendly alternative saving you money and the planet!

Scrubbies are a brilliant addition to your facial beauty regime, not only offering gentle exfoliation but when paired with your favourite toner, micellar water or soap are great for removing makeup helping your skin to look and feel it's best!



Organic Cotton Yarn



Beginner friendly

3mm Crochet hook

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TOOLS AND MATERIALS

I used Stylecraft Naturals 100% organic cotton.

1 x 50g ball

1 ball of this yarn will make plenty of individual scrubbies to get you started

Colours used in cover image – Blue Lagoon, Sea Green, Dove and Flax
Colour used in step-by-step images is Blue Lagoon

A 3mm or 4mm (UK) size crochet hook works well. The 3mm hook will give you a tighter stitch.

Stitch marker

Scissors

Tapestry needle

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch – Chain.

Step 1. Yarn over and pull through loop.

SS – Slip stitch.

Step 1. insert hook into chain space.

Step 2. Yarn over and pull through space and loop on hook.

Dc – Double crochet.

Step 1. Insert hook through stitch.

Step 2. Yarn over and pull through space/stitch (2 loops on hook)

Step 3. Yarn over again and pull this through the 2 loops on hook leaving 1 loop on hook.

Htr – Half treble.

Step 1. Yarn over

Step 2. Insert hook through stitch.

Step 3. Yarn over and pull through the space/stitch (3 loops on hook)

Step 4. Yarn over again and pull this through all 3 loops on hook.

Tr – Treble.

Step 1. Yarn over

Step 2. Insert hook into space/stitch

Step 3. Yarn over and pull through space/stitch (3 loops on hook)

Step 4. Yarn over again & pull through 2 loops on hook (2 loops on hook)

Step 5. Yarn over again and pull through the 2 loops on hook.

NOTES

Place a stitch marker at the start of each round, if you don't have a stitch marker then a piece of contrasting yarn would work instead.

This pattern uses UK crochet terms.

This pattern is worked in a continuous spiral.

SPECIAL STITCH

3 TrCl – Treble cluster.

Step 1. As step 1 – 4 of **Tr**, repeat 3 times.

Step 5. Now with 4 loops on hook, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.



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Step 1. Make a slip knot (see image) Insert hook into the loop and gently pull down on both strands of the yarn to close around hook, leaving a small gap to allow yarn to move easily across hook.

Before working with the yarn, make sure the short tail end that you're NOT working with sits on the right-hand side (if you're left-handed then this will need to sit on the left side)

Step 2. Ch 2

Round 1. 6 Dc into 2nd chain from hook. (6)

Insert stitch marker into the top of last Dc, continue to move it into last stitch of each round as you go.

Round 2. 2 Dc in each stitch around. Otherwise known as 1 Inc (increase) x 6 (12)

Round 3. (Htr in next stitch 2 Htr in next stitch) x 6 (18)

Round 4. Htr in next 2 stitches 2 Htr in next stitch) x 6 (24)

Round 5. (Tr in next 3 stitches 2 Tr in next stitch) x 6 (30)

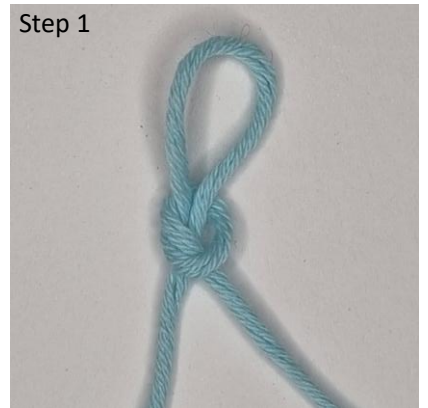
Round 6. (Htr in next 4 stitches) (4 TrCl stitch, Ch 1, 4 TrCl, Ch 1 into next stitch) x 6 (45)

Round 7. Finish off by 1 Htr in next stitch, 1 Dc into 2nd stitch, SS into 3rd & final stitch. This brings the height of the stitches down making a neater and more rounded finish to the scrubbie.

With last loop on hook, cut yarn leaving a short tail of yarn to weave in & pull through fastening off.

Using tapestry needle weave in tail ends at the back of the scrubbie as neatly as you can through stitches to secure.
